Resolution No. 27: Change in Payment of Transportation for Authorized Legionnaires to Attend Scheduled Meetings from Foreign Departments
Origin: Resolution No. 437 (MX) 1974 National Convention
Submitted by: Finance Commission

WHEREAS, The American Legion is composed of 58 departments, six of which are extraterritorial, to wit: Mexico, Panama Canal Zone, Canada, Philippines, France, Italy; and

WHEREAS, It has been the policy of the national organization to pay the authorized Legionnaires of extraterritorial departments travel compensation only from their point of entry into the United States of American for attendance at meetings; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 8-9, 1975, That in lieu of the present method of payment of transportation for those authorized from extraterritorial departments including department commanders, adjutants, members of the National Executive Committee, and any members of commissions or committees as authorized by the national adjutant, we recommend that they receive reimbursement for transportation at coach fare rate from their city of residence to the authorized meeting site.
