WHEREAS, USA Shooting, the National Governing Body of Olympic Shooting and the Civilian Marksmanship Program recognize The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program as the premier grassroots youth marksmanship program in the Nation; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion is a member of the National Three-Position Air Rifle Council which also consists of representatives from Boy Scouts of America-Venturing, the Civilian Marksmanship Program, Daisy/U.S. Jaycees Shooter Education Program, 4-H Shooting Sports, the National Guard Marksmanship Training Center, and USA Shooting; and

WHEREAS, The National Three-Position Air Rifle Council is active in the promotion and development of Three-Position Air Rifle shooting in the United States; and

WHEREAS, The National Three-Position Air Rifle Council conducts an annual National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship under the administration of the Civilian Marksmanship Program and USA Shooting; and

WHEREAS, Many individuals and teams competing in the annual National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship are affiliated with The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program; and

WHEREAS, Daisy Manufacturing, Incorporated has generously donated \$1,000 to The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program; and

WHEREAS, The National Americanism Commission desires to provide recognition of the achievements of the top performing Individual and Team in the Sporter and Precision categories competing in the annual National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship who are affiliated with The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, May 9-10, 2001, That The National Organization is hereby authorized to accept the gift of \$1,000.00 from Daisy Manufacturing, Incorporated; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the funds be used to purchase travelling trophies for the top performing Individual and Team in the Sporter and Precision categories competing in the annual National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship who are members of clubs and teams affiliated with The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the National Americanism Commission is authorized to annually present The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Trophies to the top performing Individual and Team in the Sporter and Precision categories competing in the annual National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship who are members of clubs and teams affiliated with The American Legion Junior Shooting Sports Program; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That these awards be initially presented at the 2001 National Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship in Atlanta, Georgia, and that the awards be included in the next edition of the American Legion Trophies Manual.**
