**RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, October 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 1926, That the recognition of distinguished service rendered to the world by Marshal Ferdinand Foch, commander-in-chief of the allied Armies of the World War, and General John J. Pershing, commander-in-chief of the American Expeditionary Forces, The American Legion does at this its Eighth National Convention, confer on them and each of them the title of "Honorary Commander of The American Legion."**
