Resolution No. 12: Political Use of Legion's Name

WHEREAS, The name of this organization has been used by certain parties in political conventions, interviews and advertisements, representing that The American Legion has taken certain positions on various partisan policies; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in San Antonio, Texas, October 8, 9, 10, 11, 1928, That the American Legion does hereby report itself as condemning such tactics, and recommends to the national headquarters that any member of The American Legion or otherwise, who is not a duly authorized representative of this organization and who is not duly authorized to speak for it on issues pertaining only to the organization and its policies, be openly rebuked whenever they attempt to represent The American Legion as favoring or disfavoring any partisan issue.
