RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Boston, Massachusetts, October 6, 7, 8, 9, 1930, That we believe American citizenship is a privilege to be conferred only upon those who wholly accept the responsibilities involved, and not upon those who demand or propose special terms; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That, consequently, we believe that no person should be admitted to citizenship in our United States who is unwilling to take an unqualified oath of allegiance to our government.
