Resolution No. 387: Compilation of Veterans Based on 1930 Census Urged

(Consolidated with Resolution Nos. 337 (MI) and 373 (OR))

WHEREAS, The 1930 National Census included certain questions purporting to show the number of veterans located in each of the census districts; and

WHEREAS, The successful preparation for and carrying on of work for the disabled and their dependents is predicated upon a knowledge of the facts which would be indicated in a compilation of these figures; and

WHEREAS, The director of the census and the director of veterans affairs have failed to correlate their activities to the end that this compilation can be made; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Detroit, Michigan, September 21, 22, 23, 24, 1931, That the Secretary of Commerce be requested to take such steps as will bring about the compilation and dissemination of the census figures relating to veterans.
