RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in New York, New York, September 20, 21, 22, 23, 1937, That The American Legion acknowledges the necessity of restoring our useful wildlife by the protection of its environment as a national responsibility and pledges its support to the efforts of the federal and state governments to this end; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That The American Legion urges all local posts and state organizations to take an active interest in constructive measures which will help restore nature's balance, that we may recover much of our lost heritage wasted by overkilling, the destruction of many of the most favorable feeding and breeding areas, the erosion of the soil, the burning and wasteful cutting of the forests, and the pollution of our waterways.
