**Resolution No. 856: Issuance of Temporary and Permanent Post Charters

WHEREAS, In many instances temporary charters have been issued by the departments to various posts of The American Legion covering a probationary period; and

WHEREAS, No permanent charter is issued in such instances until approved by the department involved; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in San Francisco, California, September 30, October 1, 2, 3, 4, 1946, That in all instances where temporary charters are issued in the future the probationary period during which said charter is to continue in existence shall not exceed a period of one year, upon the termination of which the department shall determine whether a permanent charter shall be issued or denied and the action of the department shall be final.
