RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Miami, Florida, October 18, 19, 20, 21, 1948, That in any publicity and advertising for The American Legion Poppy Day and other memorial tributes to our war dead, that if religious symbols are used that symbols of all religious faiths, which are recognized and used by the United States Graves Registration Service be incorporated in such publicity and advertising.
