**Resolution No. 759: Limit Period During Which Resolutions Requiring National
Legislation Shall Continue Effective**

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Miami, Florida, October 18, 19, 20, 21, 1948, That all resolutions requiring national legislation shall be effective only to the date of final adjournment of the Congress, during which such resolutions were adopted by a national convention or the National Executive Committee, except that resolutions passed at the national convention or the National Executive Committee meeting immediately preceding the convening of a new Congress, shall be effective until the adjournment of such new Congress; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become effective at the date of the final adjournment of the 81st Congress.
