**RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Cleveland, Ohio, September 27, 28, 29, 1920, That our deep and genuine interest in the Boy Scouts of American be continued for the coming year; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That we assist by every available means the formation of new troops in the different localities in our nation; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That we urge members of The American Legion, through the delegates here assembled, to assist in the formation of these troops and to seek out suitable members from their post to organize and instruct the boys in their communities in Scoutcraft and to be their Scout leaders.**
