**RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in New Orleans, Louisiana, October 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 1922, That the national adjutant direct all departments of The American Legion to maintain a Service Division, under a competent director whose duty it shall be to assist claimants to the Veterans' Bureau in the proper presentation of their claims and to give intelligent assistance to service claims to hasten the completion and adjudication of such claims.**
