Resolution No. 28: Award of Distinguished Service Medal to Frank Knox

WHEREAS, Provision is made for the awarding of the National American Legion Distinguished Service Medal, upon nomination by the national commander or any department of the Legion, with the approval of this committee and two-thirds majority approval of the National Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, Secretary Frank Knox has been nominated by the Department of New Hampshire for this high honor, said nomination being supported by a department resolution outlining the outstanding service he has rendered the country for many years, and said nomination being supported and approved by the national commander; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Washington, D.C. on April 30, May 1-2, 1944, That we award the American Legion Distinguished Service Medal posthumously to Frank Knox in recognition of his outstanding service to The American Legion and his community, state and nation.
