**Resolution No. 5: Permanent Charters**

**Origin: Wisconsin**

**Submitted by: National Executive Committee  
(As Amended)**

WHEREAS, No post of The American Legion shall be permanently chartered except on the recommendation of the department in which such post is situated; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Washington, D.C. on February 7, 1921, That a permanent charter will not be approved or issued to a post by a department until the department is satisfied that all conditions are present to indicate that such post will be able to maintain itself and to continue its existence; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That a permanent charter being once granted to a post, will not be revoked or altered, except upon recommendation of the department affected.**
