**Resolution No. 6: Official Badge of the American Legion to be Presented to General
Josef Haller**

WHEREAS, Upon the invitation of The American Legion, General Josef Haller is visiting the United States and is attending the Fifth Annual Convention of The American Legion and presents to the Legion and ex-service men and women of America, the greetings of our distinguished brothers-in-arms of Poland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in San Francisco, California, on October 14, 1923, That in recognition of the respect, admiration and the affection which The American Legion has for the distinguished guest now honoring us, and those whom he represents, and as a mark of our esteem and gratification at the honor thus paid us, The American Legion in convention assembled hereby authorizes General Joseph Haller to wear the official badge of The American Legion inscribed "Distinguished Service" and directs the national commander, upon behalf of The American Legion, to present to General Josef Haller and official badge of The American Legion suitably engraved.
