**Resolution No. 29: Circularization of Proposed Budget  
Origin: Subcommittee on Resolutions  
Submitted by: Subcommittee on Resolutions**

WHEREAS, The National Executive Committee at its meeting on November 23 to 24, 1934, requested the National Finance Committee to send to all members of the National Executive Committee prior to its first meeting after the election of a new national commander the itemized budget for the following year, the budget of the past year, and likewise the financial report; and

WHEREAS, It is physically impossible to make up the budget for the ensuing year prior to the meeting of the National Finance Committee, which necessarily closely precedes the meeting of the National Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, This report becomes impossible of fulfillment under the circumstances; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 2-3 1935, That we hereby rescind that particular portion of our request of November 23 to 24, 1934, having to do with circularization of the proposed budget for the ensuing year; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That we require only, in advance, the copy of the current year's budget, together with copy of the latest available financial report—such copies to be furnished to the members of the National Executive Committee prior to both the May and November meetings of the National Executive Committee.**
