WHEREAS, The work of the Subcommittee on Resolutions has been hampered and impeded and in many cases rendered exceedingly difficult by reason of the submission of memoranda, telegrams and letters addressed to the national organization in lieu of properly prepared resolutions; and

WHEREAS, It is contemplated that all matters referred to the Subcommittee on Resolutions should be in resolution form and should have proper Legion sponsorship; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on November 18–19, 1938, That as a condition precedent to the consideration of the Subcommittee on Resolutions of any resolution, that the same be in proper form and have proper Legion sponsorship.**
