WHEREAS, Over 1,000,000 men are now receiving military training in the Army of the United States; and

WHEREAS, In the comparatively short time since the declaration of the emergency, cantonments have been built and adequate provision made for clothing, housing, maintaining and training our Army; and

WHEREAS, Great progress has been made in the expansion of our Navy; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in special meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on March 14-15, 1941, That The American Legion commends our National Defense Agencies for the rapid and efficient manner in which they have carried out the initial phases of our defense preparation.
