**Resolution No. 36: Control of Solicitation of Funds

WHEREAS, Some confusion now exists as to the authority of departments and posts of The American Legion and members thereof in the name of The American Legion to solicit funds; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on November 18-19, 1943, That there shall be no solicitation of funds in the name of The American Legion for any project or purpose outside of the departmental boundaries of any department of The American Legion except by expressed permission of the Department Executive Committee of the other department or departments; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That the various departments, either by convention action or the action of the Department Executive Committee, shall be authorized to regulate the solicitation of funds within the boundaries of said respective department.**
