**Resolution No. 37: 4-F Draft Classification  
Origin: National Defense Committee

WHEREAS, There are in our country, according to statistics furnished by Selective Service Boards, over two million men in draft age now classified as 4-F, who could be transferred to 1-A classification if remediable faults were corrected; and

WHEREAS, The repair of these physical faults will open up a great reservoirs of manpower for the armed forces; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 6-7, 1943, That The American Legion recommends the induction into service of all men of draft age who may be made physically fit and their assignment, when physically able, to duty in the armed services or other defense activity.**
