**Resolution No. 27: Appointment of Successor Trustees of American Legion September 11,
2001 Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund**

WHEREAS, The National Executive Committee authorized the American Legion as settlor to create the American Legion September 11 Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund on May 8-9, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Hoosier Trust Company of Indianapolis, Indiana and its successor First Merchants Private Wealth Advisors of Carmel, Indiana were named trustee; and

WHEREAS, Settlor reserved the right, upon written 30 day notice, to remove such trustee under Article Six page Five of the Declaration of Trust; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled virtually on May 5–6, 2021, That First Merchants Private Wealth Advisors of Carmel, Indiana is hereby removed as trustee for the American Legion September 11, 2001 Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund effective June 15, 2021; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the national commander, the Finance Commission chairperson, the NEC Finance Commission Liaison Committee chairperson, the American Legion Charities, Inc treasurer, the national treasurer, and the national adjutant (only as member with voice and no vote) be appointed trustees of the American Legion September 11, 2001 Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund effective June 15, 2021; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the national adjutant be and is hereby authorized and directed to deliver or mail to First Merchants Private Wealth Advisors of Carmel, Indiana, a certified copy of this resolution with the corporate seal affixed thereto; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That all of the provisions set forth in the present American Legion September 11, 2001 Memorial Scholarship Trust as executed, with respect to the Trustee shall have the same force and effect and be binding upon the national commander, the Finance Commission chairperson, The NEC Finance Commission Liaison Committee chairperson, the American Legion Charities, Inc. treasurer, the national treasurer and the national adjutant (only as member with voice and no vote) as successor trustees.
