**Resolution No. 1: Creation of “Sons of The American Legion Oversight Committee”
Origin: Internal Affairs Commission
Submitted by: Finance Commission**

WHEREAS, The Sons of The American Legion is an integral and important program of The American Legion and has been since 1932; and

WHEREAS, It is important for The American Legion to maintain oversight for financial and management purposes; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 6-7, 2021, That the National Executive Committee of The American Legion authorizes the creation of a “Sons of The American Legion Oversight Committee,” which will report directly to the American Legion Internal Affairs Commission; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That said committee will comprise a chairman and two members which may be members of the American Legion Internal Affairs Commission or whoever The American Legion national commander may recommend for appointment; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That one member shall serve one year, one member shall serve two years, and one member shall serve three years, and thereafter, one shall be selected annually to serve for a period of three years; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the chairman shall be appointed annually; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That in addition to the three members of the “Sons of The American Legion Oversight Committee,” The American Legion national commander may appoint from time to time additional consultants who will serve one-year terms; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That appointments to fill members’ expiring terms shall be made annually by the National Executive Committee of The American Legion, based on the recommendation of The American Legion national commander.
