**Resolution No. 10: Support for Employment Navigator and Partnership Pilot  
Origin: Veterans Employment & Education Commission  
Submitted by: Veterans Employment & Education Commission**

WHEREAS, The U.S. Dept of Labor (DOL), Veterans' Employment and Training Service (VETS) is partnering with high caliber employment and training entities from the public and private sectors to conduct a pilot to better assist transitioning servicemembers and their spouses; and

WHEREAS, The Employment Navigator and Partnership Pilot (ENPP) is provided outside of the formal DOL Transition Assistance Program (TAP) classroom instruction and provides one-on-one career assistance to participants; and

WHEREAS, To be eligible for the program, participants must be transitioning servicemembers, or their spouses; within two years of retirement or 365 days of separation; and participate in TAP services at one of the designated 13 ENPP locations; and

WHEREAS, Servicemembers and their spouses may connect with an Employment Navigator at one of the pilot locations and receive assistance securing meaningful and lasting post-separation careers; and

WHEREAS, ENPP services consist of self-assessments, skills testing, resume reviews, identification of high demand occupations and necessary credentials, labor market research, and referrals of government and non-government partners for additional or continued services; and

WHEREAS, Partnership services include apprenticeship opportunities, employment networking, referral to employment opportunities, digital matching (platforms that match skills and experience with potential employment opportunities), hiring events, training services, employment mentorship, placement services, and wrap around services (provides a combination of services based upon individual needs); and

WHEREAS, The ENPP is currently a pilot program and data is not currently available to evaluate its effectiveness; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 6-7, 2021, That the U.S. Department of Labor, Veteran's Employment and Training Service continue with the Employment Navigator and Partnership Pilot to evaluate its effectiveness.**
