Origin: Resolution No. 37 (NY) 2022 National Convention

WHEREAS, Past National Commander's Aides have been in existence since 1937; and
WHEREAS, The past national commander's aides is a group of individuals who have served
The American Legion traveling along with the national commander; and

WHEREAS, It has been proposed that this group form an association for the purpose of
friendship and camaraderie; and

WHEREAS, There will be three (3) officers of this association, president, secretary and
treasurer; and

WHEREAS, The association would meet once a year at the national convention for a social
time of those members and conduct any business that may arise; and

WHEREAS, Membership in the association is voluntary and not mandatory; and

WHEREAS, Participation in the paying of annual dues is also voluntary and at a minimum
amount; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion, Department of New York supports and strongly
recommends a Past National Commander's Aide's Association be authorized by the national
organization; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular
meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 12-13, 2022, That the existence of
the Past National Commander's Aide's Association be authorized formally by the National
Executive Committee as of approval of this resolution and meeting date and any constitution
and by-laws be approved by the national judge advocate and the Internal Affairs
Commission; and, be it finally**

**RESOLOVED, That all funds from dues or other sources, to be used for operational
expenses of the association, will be deposited with and records maintained by the national
Finance Division which shall report same to the national Finance Commission and provide
status of the fund to the Past National Commander's Aide's Association treasurer for their
annual meeting at National Convention.**
