**Resolution No. 19: Amendment to Correct Regulations Governing the Color of Piping on  
The American Legion Caps**

**Origin: Emblem Committee**

WHEREAS, It has been called to our attention that regulations governing the color of piping on American Legion caps as established by Resolution No. 58, National Executive Committee, April 30 - May 1, 1964, are in conflict with American Legion cap detailed specifications, annually approved by the National Executive Committee of The American Legion (most recently by Resolution No. 21, National Executive Committee, May 7-8, 1997); and

WHEREAS, These regulations and detailed specifications have been reviewed and the National Emblem Committee wishes to eliminate the conflict between the regulations and the detailed specifications; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, October 15-16, 1997, That the first sentence of part 2, Resolution No. 58, National Executive Committee, April 30 - May 1, 1964, is amended to read as follows:**

**2. COUNTY OFFICER CAP-All blue, piped in white and lettered in white.**
