**Resolution No. 19: To Create Additional Employer-of-the Year Category
Origin: Register Resolution No. 2264 (NC) 1990 DEC
Submitted by: Internal Affairs Commission**

WHEREAS, Current National Economic Commission criteria for nomination of employers for awards do not adequately discriminate between "large" and "small" employers; and

WHEREAS, Employers that vary in size from five (5) to two hundred (200) employees could have very little in common in the employment of veterans; and

WHEREAS, A category of employers consisting of fifty (50) employees or fewer would allow the truly small and medium companies, which represent the majority of their own size while not diluting the importance of larger companies; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 13-14, 1992, To endorse Employer-of-the-Year Awards categories consisting of Small Employers (1-50 employees), Medium Employers (51-200 employees) and Large Employers (more than 200 employees) and recommend the adoption of said categories by the National Economic Commission.
