**Resolution No. 34: *American Legion Magazine* Printing Services Contract with R.R. Donnelley & Sons**

WHEREAS, The American Legion's current contract with R.R. Donnelley & Sons Company for the printing of *The American Legion Magazine* and for the supplying of body paper to *The American Legion Magazine* will expire on December 31, 1999; and

WHEREAS, R.R. Donnelley & Sons Company continues to be highly competitive in its field and has provided The American Legion with outstanding service and a competitive pricing structure throughout the duration of the current contract; and

WHEREAS, *The American Legion Magazine* Commission authorized the Publisher/Editor-in-Chief and Commission Chairman to pursue a renewal of the current printing and paper contract with R.R. Donnelley & Sons Company, with provisions for an additional one-year/three-year option for renewal, said contract to have substantially the same provisions as the current contract, and authorized the Chairman to recommend that the National Finance Commission and National Executive Committee approve same; and

WHEREAS, R.R. Donnelley & Sons Company has agreed to enter into such negotiations and has agreed to the continuation of the contract on basically the same terms as now exist; and

WHEREAS, The National Finance Commission has reviewed the recommendation of *The American Legion Magazine* Commission and hereby recommends approval of said contract to the National Executive Committee; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 5-6, 1999, That it does hereby grant approval for entering into a three-year contract with R.R. Donnelley & Sons Company, commencing on January 1, 2000, for the purpose of supplying printing body paper on a monthly basis to *The American Legion Magazine*, said contract to have appropriate provisions for an American Legion option to renew said contract for one or three years upon completion of the original term; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That the National Commander be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract renewal when reviewed and approved as to terms and conditions by the National Judge Advocate, and the National Adjutant be and he is hereby authorized and directed to attest the same.**
