Resolution No. 30: Rescinding of National Americanism Program Non-Legislative Policy Resolutions (Education)

WHEREAS, In accordance with resolutions of the 1959 and 1960 National Convention, the National Executive Committee, through its Program Study Committees, has caused to be made a review of all non-legislative policy resolutions, and such action has been taken in further consideration with the action of the 1936 National Convention which established policy on the life of such resolutions; and

WHEREAS, The National Americanism Commission has concluded an extensive review of three National Executive Committee resolutions relating to the National Americanism Program from the year 1959 through 1992; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 14-15, 1992, That the following resolutions be and they are hereby rescinded by reason of being superseded by later resolution.
