WHEREAS, The American Legion actively promotes those principles of sacrifice and love of their fellow countrymen; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion, in recognition of the above facts, mutually supports these ideals and honors the memory of these Four Chaplains; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, September 7, 8, 9, 1993, That The American Legion opposes the permanent placement of symbols and artifacts in the Chapel of Four Chaplains by groups other than those of Protestant, Catholic and Jewish faiths as a memorial to only those Four Chaplains honored.
