to Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program**

WHEREAS, American Legion departments are strongly encouraged by the Americanism Commission to sponsor a Junior Law Cadet program in cooperation with their State Police or Highway Patrol, of which the name of department programs have varied to include such terms as the Student Trooper Program, Trooper Week Program, Law Enforcement Training, etc.; and

WHEREAS, The Americanism Commission considers using “Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program” as the program title to be more descriptive of the type of program and also more reflective of the maturity of the participants involved; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 7-8, 2014, That the name of The American Legion Junior Law Cadet Program be changed to *The American Legion Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program*.**
