**Resolution No. 10: Authorization for The American Legion to Enter into a Relationship to
Promote a Vehicle Donation Program**

Origin: Revenue Enhancement Committee

Submitted by: Finance Commission

WHEREAS, The American Legion encourages the solicitation and acceptance of gifts from individuals, corporations and foundations for purposes that help The American Legion to further and fulfill its mission; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion wishes to provide a turn-key program to its membership to facilitate the donation of any vehicle (cars, trucks, motorcycles, RV's, boats, airplanes, heavy equipment, farm machinery, etc.) to benefit American Legion Charities; and

WHEREAS, There would be no liability or fundraising expense to The American Legion for using a vehicle donation program; and

WHEREAS, There would be no costs to donors for using the services of a vehicle donation program; and

WHEREAS, This resolution has the approval of your Revenue Enhancement Committee, your Finance Commission and the Subcommittee on Resolutions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 15-16, 2014, That The American Legion be authorized to enter into an agreement with a national company, as recommended by the Revenue Enhancement Committee and approved by the Finance Commission, to offer and provide vehicle donation services; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That departments of The American Legion may share in the revenue, in proportion, as determined by the Finance Commission; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That the National Commander, after review and approval by the National Judge Advocate, be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement and the National Adjutant be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest to same.
