**Resolution No. 10: Assignment of 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Observance Committee to Internal Affairs  
Commission**

WHEREAS, The 100th Anniversary Observance Committee was approved by the National Executive Committee (Resolution No. 31, May 2011) to be formed and the national commander is authorized to appoint members to serve on said committee until completion of duties after the 2019 National Convention; and

WHEREAS, The National Executive Committee approved Resolution No. 30 (NEC, Spring 2012), Subject: Appointment of National Historian to the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee; and

WHEREAS, The Internal Affairs Commission has approved the assignment of the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee to the Internal Affairs Commission and placement within the Outline of Authorization; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 14-15, 2015, That the National Executive Committee hereby approves the responsibilities and authorities of the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee and assignment to the Internal Affairs Commission effective October 14, 2015; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee purpose shall be to work in concert, as directed and approved by the National Executive Committee, with American Legion posts, districts, departments and the general public to build awareness and support for The American Legion's 100th anniversary of the founding of The American Legion in 1919, and such other purposes as may be assigned to it by the National Executive Committee; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee shall consist of a chairman, a vice chairman, and not to exceed fifteen members selected at large and approved by the national commander and the National Executive Committee; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the national commander is authorized to make such interim appointments as may be required to fill vacancies, subject to ratification by the National Executive Committee at its next ensuing meeting; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the national historian be appointed as an ex-officio member of the committee each year; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the national adjutant make national staff, as may be necessary, available to work with the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee for the purposes of research and assistance; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the national commander, upon recommendation of the chairman of the 100th Anniversary Observance Committee, may appoint such consultants with at least one each from The American Legion Auxiliary and the Sons of The American Legion as well as national commander's representatives as deemed appropriate; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That the "Outline of Authorization: Membership and Purpose for Commissions and Committees" shall be updated to reflect the above; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 31 (NEC, May 2011) titled, "Creation Of A Committee To Formulate Plans For Observance Of The 100th Anniversary Of The American Legion" and Resolution No. 30 (NEC, May 2012) titled, "National Historian To Serve On The 100th Anniversary Committee" are hereby superseded and rescinded.**
