Resolution No. 27: Per Diem for Department Historian for Annual Conference & Workshop

WHEREAS, Resolutions have been submitted from the Department of Rhode Island, to authorize per diem for Department Historians to attend the Fall conference and workshop in Indianapolis, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, The National Convention of The American Legion has urged all members to maintain an interest in the history of the organization; and

WHEREAS, Implementation of this program through workshops for Department Historians has been undertaken by the National Association of Department Historians of The American Legion, in cooperation with the National Historians; and

WHEREAS, Annually there is held under the supervision of the National Historian and NADHAL, at National Headquarters in Indianapolis, a conference to review, augment and exchange ideas to encourage greater participation in the National History Contests; and

WHEREAS, At this same meeting, the Historians who are present act as judges for the National History Contests; and

WHEREAS, Many Department Historians do not attend this conference because of failure or inability of their Department or the National Headquarters to provide some financial assistance for such attendance; now, therefore, be it;

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 18-19, 1989, That to further the goals of The American Legion to maintain and encourage interest in recording the history of the organization, that The American Legion reimburse all Department Historians two days per diem, if they attend the Fall Historians conference and workshop.
