Resolution No. 24: Law and Order

WHEREAS, Following the precepts of the Constitution of the United States and the Declaration of Independence and the principle upon which our nation was founded; and

WHEREAS, We deplore the crime on our streets and on our campuses and the vicious and seditious attacks, both printed and verbal, upon the government of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, We do therefore pass the following proposal in an attempt to correct these problems; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in Portland, Oregon, September 1, 2, 3, 1970, That we will work to eliminate corruption at all levels of government and that we will strive for prosecution where corruption is found; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That we will strive for the removal from positions of trust of those irresponsible person who encourage, aid and alert our youth in the commission of crime in an attempt to correct social ills, rather than through the democratic process.
