**Resolution No. 29: National Executive Committee Study of Resolution No. 28, Sons of The American Legion Constitution and By-Laws Revision providing a Framework for a National Organization**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 28, emanating from the Internal Affairs Commission, deals with a National Constitution and National By-Laws for Sons of The American Legion Organization; and

WHEREAS, This resolution was received by the Resolutions Subcommittee of the National Executive Committee of The American Legion on October 19, 1971, thereby preventing proper consideration for a recommendation; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, October 16-17, 1968, That we thank the Sons of The American Legion Committee and the young men who cooperated with this committee, the National Judge Advocate, and members of the Internal Affairs Commission for their efforts in bringing this resolution to this state of development; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 28 (National Executive Committee of October 20-21, 1971) be distributed to each National Executive Committeeman for his study; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 28 be considered as a special order of Business at the May, 1972, National Executive Committee meeting.**
