WHEREAS, The American Legion has an opportunity with United Services Automobile Association (USAA) (an insurance and financial company), to form a strategic relationship; and

WHEREAS, USAA is an organization founded by military members, for military members and available only to military members, veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, USAA has an impeccable reputation for products, customer service and integrity in its operations; and

WHEREAS, USAA can offer annuities, long term care, Medicare solutions, home owners warranties and other products that may become available, thereby producing a significant amount of revenue to The American Legion; and

WHEREAS, The National Insurance Committee and the National Finance Commission have reviewed this resolution and recommend its approval; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 5-6, 2010, That The American Legion be authorized to enter into an agreement by and between United Services Automobile Association (USAA), and The American Legion to offer annuities, long term care, Medicare solutions, home owners warranties and other products that may become available; and, be it further**

**RESOLVED, That Departments of The American Legion may share in the revenue, in proportion, as determined by The National Finance Commission; and, be it finally**

**RESOLVED, That the National Commander, after review and approval by the National Judge Advocate, be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the said agreement and the National Adjutant be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest the same.**
