**Resolution No. 3: The American Legion National Recruiter of the Year
Origin: Internal Affairs Commission
Submitted by: Finance Commission**

WHEREAS, To place emphasis on membership the Membership and Post Activities Committee, along with the Trophies and Awards Committee, developed the National Recruiter of the Year Award for the individual who has recruited the most new members for the membership year; and

WHEREAS, This resolution authorizes the financial cost for this award and the travel costs to the National Convention for the purpose of annual recognition and acceptance of The American Legion National Recruiter of the Year Award; and

WHEREAS, This resolution has the concurrence of the Finance Commission, the Membership and Post Activities Committee and the Internal Affairs Commission; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 12-13, 2011, That The American Legion annually recognize during the National Convention, a National Recruiter of the Year with an appropriate award; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That The American Legion will provide one roundtrip coach airfare or vehicle mileage, in accordance with its employee mileage reimbursement rates, staff per diem for six days, two tickets to National Commander's Banquet and lodging for five nights in accordance with travel policies of The American Legion for an individual recipient to receive the award at National Convention; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That The American Legion provide roundtrip coach airfare for one guest but will provide no incidental expenses or expenses incurred by guests accompanying the award recipient; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That funds expended for purchase of an engraved 11³/₄" x 14³/₄" shadow-box plaque be set at an amount not to exceed \$350 annually, adjusted as needed for inflation; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That funds be authorized for the purchase of a special gift not to exceed \$1,000, adjusted as needed for inflation; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That the Membership and Post Activities Committee will continue to be fully authorized to develop appropriate eligibility criteria, application procedures and deadlines, and selection guidelines for department submissions.
