**Resolution No. 4: Establishment of a Detachment of The Sons of The American Legion in  
The American Legion Department of the Philippines**

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article III, of the National Constitution of the Sons of The American Legion provides in part: “The National Executive Committee may establish additional detachments (of the Sons of The American Legion) in the territorial possessions of the United States and in foreign countries”; and

WHEREAS, The Department of the Philippines by letter to the national membership director has requested authority to establish such a detachment in that department; and

WHEREAS, It is to the interest and the advantage of The American Legion that the Sons of The American Legion organization grow under the sound leadership of American Legion departments and posts; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 31-November 1, 1962, That the National Executive Committee authorizes the establishment of a detachment of the Sons of The American Legion in the Department of the Philippines in accordance with the National Constitution and By-Laws of the Sons of The American Legion.**
