**Resolution No. 43: Department American Legion Colleges Recommended

WHEREAS, The success of The American Legion in both membership performance and in program operations is largely dependent upon post leadership; and

WHEREAS, It is incumbent upon the national organization and the several department organizations of The American Legion to lend their assistance in leadership training and development; and

WHEREAS, The experience of a number of departments has clearly demonstrated the great value of well-planned department American Legion colleges; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 1-2, 1963, That the value of such colleges be called to the attention of all departments and that the Membership & Post Activities Committee and its staff be directed, upon the invitation of departments, to lend their assistance to departments in the planning and holding of such colleges insofar as travel budgets and staff time will permit.
