WHEREAS, The National Executive Committee of The American Legion desires to recognize the individual members of the Auxiliary who have demonstrated leadership in organizing Auxiliary support on a community, state and national basis; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 5-6, 1965, That the National Legislative Commission is hereby authorized as follows:**

- 1. To approve the establishment of a Legislative Leaders Club within the American Legion Auxiliary and award certificates evidencing membership therein**
- 2. To award a Card of Appreciation to those individuals in each department of the American Legion Auxiliary who, in the judgment of their department legislative chairman, have made an outstanding contribution to the legislative program of The American Legion**
- 3. To award a medal to those department legislative chairmen of the American Legion Auxiliary who have achieved excellent results in promoting the "Legislative Bulletin" and in organizing effective legislative support with the department concerned**
- 4. To award Certificates of Merit each year to the four Auxiliary departments authorized to receive it in accordance with rules established by the American Legion Auxiliary.**
