**Resolution No. 1: Child Welfare Reporting Award
Origin: Internal Affairs Commission

WHEREAS, There is presently authorized an award presented by the National Child Welfare Commission to those departments achieving 100 percent annual post child welfare reporting; and

WHEREAS, After several years' experience, the Child Welfare Commission recognizes the need for certain revisions in the rules governing eligibility to receive this award in order to increase its effectiveness; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion, in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, October 18–19, 1967, That the rules of eligibility governing the Department 100 percent Post Child Welfare Reporting Award be amended to include the following language:

- 1. Any department whose membership is equal to or above the membership of the smallest department of the 50 states and the District of Columbia shall be recognized in this award.**
- 2. The size of the departments, for comparative purposes, shall be determined by the immediately preceding full calendar year's membership for all departments concerned.**
