WHEREAS, The Past National Vice Commanders Club is a group of individuals who have served The American Legion one year along with a national commander; and

WHEREAS, There are three (3) officers of this group, i.e., president, secretary/treasurer, and historian; and

WHEREAS, The group meets once a year at the National Convention for a social time of those members and conduct any business that may arise; and

WHEREAS, Membership in the club is voluntary and not mandatory; and

WHEREAS, Participation in the paying of annual dues is also voluntary and at a minimum amount; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 9-10, 2018, That the existence of the Past National Vice Commander's Club be authorized formally by the National Executive Committee as of approval of this resolution and meeting date; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That all funds from dues or other sources, which may be used for the operational expenses of the club, will be deposited with and records maintained by the National Finance Division which shall report same to the national Finance Commission and provide status of fund to the Past National Vice Commander's Club secretary/treasurer for their annual meeting at National Convention.
