Resolution No. 541: Increased Appropriations for Direct Loan Program

WHEREAS, There is a need in certain communities, principally in less populated regions, to improve the flow of funds in order that all qualified World War II and Korean veterans can take advantage of opportunities for private home ownership under the provisions of the G. I. Bill; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in New York, New York, August 25, 26, 27, 28, 1952, That the national commander is requested to call a conference of lending organizations representing the leading financial and mortgage lending institutions to explore the possibilities of improving G.I. home loan facilities in such areas; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That this conference be held in advance of the fall meeting of 1952, meeting of the National Executive Committee, so as to insure prompt and immediate attention to this matter.
