Resolution No. 599: Meetings of the National Executive Committee

Origin: Resolution No. 4 (NEC) August 24, 1952

Submitted by: Convention Committee on Constitutional Amendments

WHEREAS, In view of the fact that the national convention is being held earlier this year;
and

WHEREAS, The commanders and adjutants conference should be held at an earlier date than in November; and

WHEREAS, It would be impractical and more expensive to hold this conference separately from the National Executive Committee meeting; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in New York, New York, August 25, 26, 27, 28, 1952, That Article I, Section 2 of the National By-laws be amended to read as follows:

“Section 2. The National Executive Committee shall meet within 24 hours before and after each national convention and within 45 days following its adjournment and in May of each year. Special meetings may be held upon reasonable notice at the call of the national commander. The national commander shall call a meeting of the National Executive Committee upon written request of National Executive Committeemen from 15 or more departments.”
