WHEREAS, Each department has established a Sons of The American Legion detachment and maintains oversight of their program; and

WHEREAS, The District of Columbia has three Sons of The American Legion squadrons, those being at George Washington Post 1, Kenneth H. Nash Post 8, and National Defense Squadron 46; and

WHEREAS, The Department of the District of Columbia Executive Committee met on May 24, 2018, and unanimously approved a resolution to form a District of Columbia, Sons of the American Legion detachment; and

WHEREAS, The Sons of The American Legion National Executive Committee is in concurrence to recognize and approve the Detachment of the District of Columbia; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on October 17-18, 2018, That the Department of the District of Columbia be approved to form a Sons of The American Legion detachment.
